

Permanent scientific vacancy in the field of post-colonial English language literature

Start date: 1 October 2021

Job description:

A full-time first assistant position in the field of post-colonial English language literature, within the Department of Modern Languages: linguistics, literature and translation.

Teaching activities:

- Teaching tasks in the field of English literature and postcolonial civilisations;
- Supervision of practical work in the field of English-language literature;
- Supervision of final dissertations.

Research Activities:

- Development of personal and collective research in the field of postcolonial literature studies;
- Supervision of doctoral theses;
- Affiliation to a research unit (UR).

Services to of the Community:

- Involvement in the activities of the Department, the Study Council;
- Participation in the promotional activities of the Faculty and the University (fairs, welcome days, etc.).

Qualifications required / profile:

- Hold a doctorate
- Demonstrate research in the field of post-colonial English language literature. In order to complement the areas currently covered by the Department, special attention will be given to candidates with a strong research background in the English-speaking Caribbean;
- Possess at least a basic knowledge of French or ensure that they have acquired it by the end of the probationary period.

Selection procedure:

Candidates will present a public lecture on a subject defined in advance by the Appointments Committee. This lecture will be followed by an interview in English.

Eligibility conditions for applications:

Must meet the required qualifications.

How to apply - required documents (English versions accepted):

- ✓ A complete curriculum vitae;
- ✓ A cover letter;

- ✓ A document setting out the skills and experience of the candidate in relation to the missions that will be entrusted to them;
- ✓ A copy of the candidate's scientific publications (in electronic format).

Conditions of recruitment:

Positions are awarded either on a permanent basis from the outset or following a positive evaluation at the end of a term of office or a fixed-term contract of up to four years.

Our institutional policy is based on diversity and equal opportunities. We select candidates on the basis of their qualities regardless of age, sexual orientation, origin, beliefs, disability or nationality.

Conditions for permanent appointment:

This position of scientist (initially a temporary assistant position) is intended to become permanent within the institution. **At the end of a maximum period of four years**, an evaluation of the successful candidate will be carried out and, in the event of a positive evaluation, confirmation at the category of First Assistant (Category A) will be proposed.

The evaluation of the three components of the activity (see above) will also include verification that the successful candidate has acquired the level of French that will enable them to work in a French-speaking professional environment.
